Four things every Soldier, Army Civilian, and support contractor of Fort Stewart/Hunter Army Airfield must know:

1. **Know that SMS is the Sustainability Management System.** We use the SMS to implement the Fort Stewart/Hunter Army Airfield Sustainability Policy.
2. **Know the basic contents of the Policy.** Refer to the policy on the back page – Remember: **ROCK of the Marne!**

R = **RESOURCES:** Prevent Pollution & Conserve Natural Resources

O = **OPTIMIZE:** Optimize the MISSION, Well-being & the Environment

C = **COMPLIANCE:** Comply with federal, state and local laws and regulations; and

K = **KEEP IMPROVING:** Strive to continually improve environmental stewardship

3. **Know the Environmental impacts of your job!**

- Know the possible causes of environmental impacts from the activities you perform and manage your activities using proper procedures.
- If you have been designated to perform an activity that could result in a significant environmental impact, you must know how to properly manage that activity.

- ### 4. **Know that everyone has a role and responsibility in Fort Stewart/Hunter Army Airfield SMS.** Our goal is to sustain the mission while minimizing impacts to the environment and maintaining the best quality of life.



Fort Stewart/Hunter Army Airfield's SMS focuses on Energy Use, Land Use and Water Use. Our SMS emphasizes Water & Energy Conservation, Threatened & Endangered Species Management, Solid Waste Reduction.

How Can You Contribute?

Recycle at Work and at Home: Don't let your efforts go to waste, keep waste and recyclables separate!

Conserve Water and Energy:

- Turn off the water while you brush your teeth.
- Sweep driveways and maintenance bays instead of spraying them down with a garden hose.
- Don't irrigate during the heat of the day.
- Close windows when running airconditioning.
- Turn lights/equipment off when not in use.
- Use energy-efficient light bulbs.

Protect Threatened & Endangered Species (TES): Be mindful of TES habitats when working in the training areas. Some areas have restrictions that must be upheld.

Adhere to Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs): Know and follow all SOPs for your job, to include recycling SOPs, spill response SOPs and hazardous waste handling guidance.
