

3. Never get behind the wheel of a vehicle or a boat after drinking, nor ride with someone who has been drinking. Always follow the rules of the road.
4. If you ride motorcycles, wear personal protective equipment. If in a vehicle, ensure everyone uses seat belts at all times. If traveling, Use TRiPS, available at <https://crc.army.mil>, and mitigate the risks by applying Risk Management to your planning.
5. With the start of a new school year, more children are on the streets. Less daylight means poorer visibility. Stay alert and watch for children standing along the street, exiting from a bus, walking or riding a bike.
