Friends of Georgia's Division:



Events within 90 days of execution affect scheduled unit training and we may not be able to support them. We are also operating under new Department of the Army Fiscal Guidance that affects our ability to provide support to new requests and even some habitually supported events. However, we will work to ensure continued support to our friends and partners throughout the region.
