What are fats?

Cooking oil, shortening, butter, margarine, meat fat, lard, food scraps, dairy products, and sauces.

Fat and grease cause:

- ◆ Clogged pipes.
- ◆ Sewer overflows into streams.
- ◆ Sewer back-ups into homes and streets.

Tips for proper disposal:

- ◆ Do not put fat and grease in drains or disposals!
- ◆ Instead, trash it.
- ◆ and...use sink strainers in food prep areas.
