What are FAP Teams?

Each FAP team consists of Family Advocacy professionals who cater to the education and training needs of Soldiers and Family Members. FAP teams assigned to each brigade builds a rapport with the command and FRG leaders. They identify and target specific trends and tailor classes and training to address challenges. They also provide a specific point of contact to work with.

FAP teams offer continuity, consistency, and convenience.

How FAP Teams benefit you!

Because we understand your mission is important, our classes can be given at any time and location for your convenience. The teams within their assigned brigades offer a wide array of classes/training such as stress and anger management, parenting, and couples communication. Prevention training is also offered for domestic violence, child abuse, and sexual assault. We can also provide classes and training to Family Readiness Groups (FRGs).
