1. Definitions:
 - a. **Convenience Center** – Un-Manned 24 hour recyclable drop-off location.
 - b. **Commingle** – Recyclables materials mixed together in a blue dumpster/container.
 - c. **Recyclable** – An item/s that can be recovered and processed into new usable products.
 - d. **Salvageable** – An item that can be re-used or sold as-is for its intended purpose.
2. Available Facilities & Locations:
 - a. Hunter Army Field –
 - 1) Recycling Center: 0730-1530, Bldg. #726 Westley Ave.
 - 2) Convenience Center: 24 Hours, Adjacent to Bldg. #610 on Georgia Hussars St.
 - b. Fort Stewart –
 - 1) Recycling Center: 0730-1600, Bldg. # 1153 at end of Italy St.
 - 2) Processing Station: 0730-1530, Bldg. # 1384 Kilpatrick Rd.
 - 3) Convenience Center: 24 Hours, Located on the corner McFarland/Sigma Street is temporarily relocated across the street.
3. Resources Available: All available with scheduled pick up service.
 - a. Roll-Off/Commercial Dumpster for Cardboard and Scrap Metal Collection
 - b. Trailers for Cardboard Collection
 - c. Front-load Dumpster for commingled collection.
4. List of Recyclables: (see enclosure)
 - a. Commingled– aluminum and steel cans, plastics, glass bottles, cardboard, paper (must be placed in a clear plastic bag with top tied closed to protect from contamination).
