MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Fort Stewart NCO Academy Dinning Facility Friday Evening, Weekend, Holiday Closure and Privately Owned Vehicle (POV) Authorization.

1. The Fort Stewart Noncommissioned Officer Academy's Dinning Facility does not serve evening dinner meals on Fridays and is closed on Weekends and Holidays throughout each Basic Leader Course (BLC) Cycle.
2. **Justification:** Fort Stewart NCO Academy conducts training Monday through Friday; there are no weekend meals served to include Friday dinner meals. Soldiers are released for the weekend. In accordance with Army Material Command guidelines, the Fort Stewart NCO Academy DFAC is closed on Friday evenings, Weekends and Holidays in compliance with utilization rate percentage each week.
3. Soldiers within a 50 mile radius will be allowed to leave the NCO Academy on Friday evening for the weekend and return for Training on the following Monday.
4. Soldiers on a Meal Card Plan or in a Temporary Duty (TDY) Status not living within 50 mile radius of Fort Stewart NCO Academy will be afforded the opportunity to remain in the Barracks (Government Quarters) at NO COST to the Soldier. **Soldiers are Authorized the Per Diem Meals and Incidental (M&IE) 75% Locality Flat Rate (\$38.25) per day for Friday, Weekends and Holidays.** Soldiers in a TDY Status while attending Basic Leader Course and collecting Basic Allowance for Subsistence (BAS) are required to pay for Government Meals consumed in the Military Dining Facility.
5. Soldiers are authorized privately owned vehicles (POV) while attending Basic Leader Course. In-And-Around Miles not authorized. Soldiers traveling to Fort Stewart NCO Academy by Air; shuttle service to and from the Airport is not available. Taxi Fare to and from Airport is \$75.00 one way (\$150.00 Round Trip). Recommend Soldiers be authorize a Rental Car at the Unit's Expense (i.e. United States Army Reserve). Fort Stewart NCO Academy is not a Military Training Specific Allotment (MTSA) Site.
