2. Soldiers from out-of-state / not assigned to Fort Stewart or Hunter Army Airfield must sign-in NLT 1700 hours one day prior to the scheduled report date. All Soldiers Scheduled to attend BLC must be seated in the Fort Stewart NCO Academy Briefing Center, Bldg. 19218; dressed in the Army Physical Fitness Uniform (APFU) no later than 0530 hours on the scheduled Start Date.

3. Each Soldier must have Military Identification, Common Access Card (CAC), Identification Tags, Meal Card (DD Form 714), and complete school's packet. Soldiers on Basic Allowance for Subsistence (BAS) are required to pay in cash for Government Meals while attending Basic Leader Course. Students upon in-processing must present a copy of their SSD Skill Level 1 Certificate of Completion, and a copy of their "Diagnostic Army Physical Fitness Test (DA Form 705) within 60 days of scheduled class start date in order to attend Basic Leader Course.

4. All Soldiers attending the Basic Leader Course will maintain their military appearance in accordance with the standards outlined in the Army Regulation 670-1. Soldiers cannot report to school with a temporary profile. Soldier with Permanent P3 Profile must provide a copy of the MOS Medical Retention Board (MMRB) result proceedings to the school / NCO Academy.
